

## Procurement of automatic Frequency Restoration Reserve (aFRR) in Q3/2019

The Nordic TSOs have decided to increase the procurement of aFRR in Q3 2019 by:

- increasing the number of procurement hours from 48 to 61 hours/week including procurement in week-ends
- increasing the total volume from 300 MW to 400 MW in morning hours.

The basis for the procurement is the agreed goal for frequency quality level and the TSOs will continue to procure aFRR in the morning and evening hours Monday-Friday as well as the dayshift hours where the frequency variations are most challenging. In addition the TSOs now include some hours in the week-end.

The procurement schedule until week 26 will follow the earlier published information.

Starting from Monday 1 July 2019, aFRR will be procured in the following hours in Central European Time (CET):
